Scholarship Rules

1. Entrants must be a registered member of a 4-H Dairy Club in B.C. for a minimum of 3 years and attending the I.P.E. with their 2010 projects.
2. Must be pursuing a post secondary education in Agriculture, Agri- business or a Agriculture related discipline
3. ONLY entrants age seventeen (17) or older as of January 1, 2010 are eligible.
4. Entrant MUST be entered in and participated in each of the following classes:
 - a) At least one (1) 4-H Dairy conformation class
 - b) 4-H Showmanship/ fitting
 - c) 4-H Judging Competition, completing their two (2) judging classes
 - d) Successfully written and passed their 4-H Junior Proficiency Test
5. Money will be sent directly to winning applicant when proof of enrollment at specified institution is received. Proof of enrollment can be any, but not limited to, the following documentation:
 - a) Receipt of tuition paid
 - b) Bill for tuition due with valid student identification number
 - c) Scholarship must be claimed within two (2) years

The winning Applicant must submit necessary documentation to the IPE 4-H Committee.
If no documentation is received, money will go back into the scholarship fund; the winner will forfeit all rights to the scholarship money.
6. Selection process will be as follows:
 - a) Aggregate points in 4-H Dairy show for each of the above four (4) classes will determine the top three (3) senior entrants who will be notified of their achievement and will advance to an interview. In the case of multiple entries in the conformation section (i.e.: entrant shows a calf as well as a heifer from a previous achieved project,) the entrants best placing will be taken as the score to be used for aggregate points.
 - b) The interview process will consists of a panel of three (3) judges. The judges will follow a score card and will award points in the areas of:
 - 20% Secondary education or Post secondary education
 - 20%, Dairy involvement
 - 40% 4-H Program & Project involvement
 - 20%. Other, community, school, etc.
 - c) The final selection will be a combination of the show portion (conformation, showmanship /fitting and judging) worth a total of eighteen (18) points, as well as the interview portion worth a total of one hundred (100) points. The winning entrant will be the one with the highest overall score out of the available one hundred and eighteen points (118).
 - d) The decision of the judge's panel is final and may not be contested.
7. Once an entrant has won the scholarship, he or she is ineligible for that specific scholarship in subsequent years.
8. Unsuccessful entrants may reapply in subsequent years.

Scholarship Rules

1. Entrants must be a registered member of a 4-H Dairy Club in B.C. for a minimum of 3 years and attending the I.P.E. with their 2010 projects.
2. Must be pursuing a post secondary education in any field of study at University, Technical or Vocational School.
3. ONLY entrants age seventeen (17) or older as of January 1, 2010 are eligible.
4. Entrant MUST be entered in and participated in each of the following classes:
 - a) at least one (1) 4-H Dairy conformation class
 - b) Showmanship/ fitting
 - c) 4-H Judging Competition, completing their two (2) judging classes
 - d) Successfully written and passed their 4-H Junior Proficiency Test
5. Money will be sent directly to winning applicant when proof of enrollment at specified institution is received. Proof of enrollment can be any, but not limited to, the following documentation:
 - a) receipt of tuition paid
 - b) bill for tuition due with valid student identification number
 - c) scholarship must be claimed within two (2) years

The winning Applicant must submit necessary documentation to the IPE 4-H Committee.
If no documentation is received, money will go back into the scholarship fund; the winner will forfeit all rights to the scholarship money.
6. Selection process will be as follows:
 - a) aggregate points in 4-H Dairy show for each of the above four (4) classes will determine the top three (3) senior entrants who will be notified of their achievement and will advance to an interview. In the case of multiple entries in the conformation section (i.e.: entrant shows a calf as well as a heifer from a previous achieved project,) the entrants best placing will be taken as the score to be used for aggregate points.
 - b) the interview process will consists of a panel of three (3) judges. The judges will follow a score card and will award points in the areas of:
 - 20% Secondary education or Post secondary education
 - 20%, Dairy involvement
 - 40% 4-H Program & Project involvement
 - 20%. Other, community, school, etc.
 - c) the final selection will be a combination of the show portion (conformation, showmanship /fitting and judging) worth a total of eighteen (18) points, as well as the interview portion worth a total of one hundred (100) points. The winning entrant will be the one with the highest overall score out of the available one hundred and eighteen points (118).
 - d) the decision of the judge's panel is final and may not be contested.
7. Once an entrant has won the scholarship, he or she is ineligible for that specific scholarship in subsequent years.
8. Unsuccessful entrants may reapply in subsequent years.
