All entries must be ear tagged and tattooed.**4-H entries cannot be shown in open class.**

All stalls must be cleaned before 8 a.m. each day. Exhibitors are required to include stall decoration as part of their exhibit, so that the exhibits will attract the attention of the public.

If you do not receive your Prize Money cheque by November 12th, Please contact the Office. All prize cheques are to be cashed by December 1st, 2010. No re-issuing of cheques will be undertaken. ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS. Prize cheques not cashed by December 1, 2010 will be considered a donation to the Interior Provincial Exhibition.**Rules & Regulations Revised 2009**

- Swine pens must be cleaned out before 8am with no manure to be put outside after the pile is removed at 9 am.
