The Junior Beef Show Senior High Aggregate Scholarship is a bursary for the purpose of assisting the youth of our communities in their pursuit of higher education. Qualifications require a history of dedication to excellence as demonstrated in their performance at the Interior Provincial Exhibition.

Scholarship Rules

1. ONLY entrants age seventeen as of January 1 of current year are eligible.
2. Entrant MUST be entered in and participate in each of the following Junior Show Classes:
  - a) At least one Beef conformation class
  - b) Showmanship
  - c) Fitting
3. Selection process will be as follows:
  - a) Aggregate highest points in Junior Show for each of the above three classes will determine top three junior entrants who will be notified of their achievement and will advance to an interview. In the case of multiple entries in the conformation section (e.g. entrant shows a cow/calf as well as a heifer), the entrants best placing will be taken as the score to be used for aggregate points.
  - b) The interview process will consist of a panel of three judges. The judges will follow a score card and will award points in the areas of post-secondary education (40%), agricultural involvement (40%) and other community activities (20%).
  - c) The final selection will be the decision of the judging panel.
  - d) The decision of the judging panel is final and may not be contested.
4. Money will be sent directly to post-secondary institution when proof of enrollment at specified institution is received. Proof of enrollment can be any, but not limited to, the following documentation:
  - a) Receipt of tuition paid  
Bill for tuition due with valid student identification number
5. The winner must submit necessary documentation to the IPE Beef Committee within two (2) years. If no documentation is received, money will go toward the next year's scholarship fund and the winner will forfeit the scholarship money.
6. Once an entrant has won the scholarship, he or she is ineligible for that specific scholarship in subsequent years.
7. Unsuccessful entrants may reapply in subsequent years.
