All display materials and exhibits remain fully intact until 8:00 pm Sunday, September 2 or prize monies will be forfeited. Move out times **may** be staggered (as assigned). Exhibitors are encouraged to leave their animals stalled overnight Sunday (**until 10:00 am on Monday**).

ENTRY FEE: \$9.00 per entry (except ribbon classes as indicated by*) plus Exhibitor Ticket unless current membership held.

A separate \$15.00 per pen clean up deposit cheque is to accompany entry forms. Please date this cheque for September 3, 2018. Returned by the Barn Boss ONLY when pens are cleaned and waste wheeled out to the outside bin and inspected by the Barn Boss before you leave the grounds.

SHOW OFFICE

NSF CHEQUES: There will be a \$25.00 charge on all NSF cheques.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL BUILDINGS ON THE IPE GROUNDS ARE SMOKE FREE.

Alcohol Consumption:

The consumption of alcoholic beverages on I.P.E. premises at any time is strictly prohibited except in designated licensed areas. Persons found consuming alcohol outside of licensed areas will face instant dismissal from this and future shows.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

01. These shows are sanctioned by the Canadian Goat Society, and all C.G.S. rules shall govern. A copy of these rules will be on site for references.
02. **Health:** All animals will be penned upon arrival. All animals will be subject to a veterinary inspection by a licensed veterinarian, and will be checked in accordance with CGS health regulations. **The health check will run Tuesday, August 28 from approximately 6 pm to 8 pm** and exhibitors are asked to remain by their animals during this process. Any animals which the veterinarian deems to be ill or injured will be excused from the show. No recently freshened does showing discharge will be allowed. Any animals found to have infectious or contagious condition will cause their whole herd disqualified and must be removed from the fairgrounds (no alternative housing available). Such conditions include - ringworm, lice, caseous lymphadenitis (C.L), orf, footrot, open sores, etc. CGS health check regulations will be posted on site, **NOTE:** the IPE reserves the right to substitute a three person health check committee, per CGS show rules.
03. **Penning:** The IPE shall have full discretion to dictate and assign stall space. Generally pens will be allotted allowing 1 pen for every 3 animals entered. **Due to limited stall space entries may be limited.** Entry fees will be refunded for those herds which we are unable to accommodate, herds will be given notification as soon as possible. All Stalls must be cleaned before 8:00 am each day, No manure from the small livestock barns to be put out after the pile has been removed
04. **Entries:** Maximum entries are restricted to 3 entries per class, per breed, per Exhibitor.

Substitutions may be accepted within classes at \$1.00 each, before Wednesday, August 30, 2018. Base date for age calculation is **August 29, 2018**. Horned animals will be barred from showing. Over-distended udders may be subject to disqualification by the judge. **NO** bucks or goats not entered in show are allowed on the grounds. Unless previously arranged at the discretion of the director eg; nursing kids or demonstration breeds.

The IPE and the Show Committee reserves the right to rearrange classes and breeds to be sanctioned after entries close as number of entries warrant

05. Milk Disposal:

No milk to be sold on fairgrounds, nor to be dumped in drains, dumpsters or septic systems. Facilities will be arranged to dispose of milk on site. Your co-operation is appreciated.

06. Registration:

The Original certificate of registration or recordation is required for each animal six months of age or older. Animals under six months of age must have papers applied for and a photocopy of application must be given to the show committee. The certificates must be available for inspection at all times. All entries must be **legibly** tattooed, and all tattoos must match certificates exactly. A tattoo/certificate check will be conducted before the show, and ineligible animals will be disqualified with no refund of entry fees. **Please check certificates/tattoos before leaving home.** If in doubt, contact your Chairperson.

07. Animal Welfare:

In recognition of minimum standards of animal welfare the IPE requires each Exhibitor to maintain their pens in a neat and clean state throughout the fair. Animals must be fed and watered regularly and adequately. If you are unable to provide the care yourself, please make arrangements for someone else to look after your herd in your absence. Failure to keep animals in a reasonable

state of appearance or provision may result in entries not being accepted the following year, upon the recommendation of the Goat Division Committee. If an animal is visibly ill or injured, the IPE reserves the right to arrange veterinary services at the expense of the herd owner, upon the recommendation of the Goat Division Committee, or the management of the IPE. Such services are payable upon provision. Outstanding fees for veterinary services will be deducted from prize money, or other efforts to collect will be made.

08. Signage

In recognition of our responsibility to inform/entertain the fair-going public, the IPE requires that each herd provide the following MINIMUM stall display information:

- a) Herd sign, minimum 1'x1' square.
- b) Identification of each animal, including at least the name, birth date and Breed shown.
- c) Decorations and educational material to attract the attention of the public, which must be in place by 10:00 am Wednesday, when the Fair opens to the public. Please ask the show committee for the possibility of access to the barn for early setup (i.e. Monday)

09. Failure to abide by the above rules or the IPE Rules starting on page 8 or with CGS show rules may result in disqualification, forfeiture of prize money and possible disbarment from the fair

If you are UNABLE to attend or you are bringing fewer animals. Please let chairperson know as soon as possible.

Rules:

- 01. We request that exhibitors voluntarily consider
refraining from entering **permanent champions** in
this show. This is NOT a restricted show, and all
entries remain at the discretion of the exhibitor.
All animals entered must have been previously
shown in the show held earlier at this years fair.
- 02. This is a CGS Sanctioned Show and the same
rules apply as for the regular show. **NO PRIZE
MONEY** will be paid. Ribbons will be awarded for
Junior and Reserve and Senior and Reserve
Champions. **Junior and Seniors will be
sanctioned separately, or all breeds combined,
as the number of entries warrant.**
- 03. Exhibitors must ensure that each animal has a
handler in show colours before show begins.

04. Substitutions will be accepted within classes prior to show day.
05. In addition to offering another chance at a championship leg, this will be a fun show and an educational show for the public. We sincerely appreciate your patience and co-operation with this program.
