REFUNDABLE PEN CLEAN UP DEPOSIT:

A separate \$15.00 per pen dated September 3, 2018 clean up deposit cheque is to accompany entry forms, refunded once pens have been cleaned and inspected

Maximum Entries: 2 entries per exhibitor per class
Sheep shown do NOT have to be owned by the exhibitor.except where noted in class description

Show colours: dark bottoms and light coloured tops

All vehicles must be off the IPE grounds by 9 am daily

Livestock Information:

Exhibits received in Livestock barns:

Tuesday August 28.

Sheep are subject to a health inspection which will take place 6 pm Tuesday August 28.

No Exhibits or displays to be removed until after 8 pm Sunday September 2 on a staggered basis or prize money will be forfeited, or with prior approval by the Chairperson. Exhibitors are invited to stay Sunday night Enjoy the rodeo and midway and leave Monday morning.

Bedding: Shavings provided. Straw will be available
Contact chair prior to the fair for information

Hay: will be available Contact chair prior to the fair for information.

Exhibitors are required to provide their own feed boxes and pails.

All Sheep require a **Canadian Sheep Identification Program Tag**. Any animal without this tag will be removed from the grounds at the owners expense. Sheep entered in Pedigree classes must be registered with CLRC(Canadian Livestock Records Association)

All Ewes & Rams are expected to have their



tails docked no shorter than the 4th tail joint. The docked tail is expected to cover the vulva in ewes and the equivalent length in rams. Tails are expected be docked NO shorter than the distal end of the caudal fold.

PRIZE MONEY:

1st: \$50.00, 2nd: \$40.00, 3rd: \$30.00, 4th: \$25.00,

RULES & REGULATIONS:

- 01. Pedigrees of purebred sheep must be produced and sheep must be legibly tattooed or double tagged with two approved tags. No animal will be accepted if tattoos are fresh.
- 02. Sheep shown in wool classes must be shown in **full natural fleece** with no evidence of trimming or combing. Sheep shown in classes other than wool classes must be shown in short fleece (staple less than one inch or 2.50 cm).
- 03. All sheep will be subject to a health inspection. Animals will be examined to insure freedom from ectoparasites and symptoms of contagious or infectious diseases. Health check will take place Tuesday August 28. Infected or contagious animals will be removed from the fair.
- 04. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to present the exhibit in an attractive form at all times with emphasis on neatness, cleanliness and educational content.
- 05. All judge's decisions will be final.
- 06. All stalls must be cleaned before 8 a.m. each day. No manure from the Sheep barns to be put out after the pile has been removed. Due to flies and odor it is highly recommend that soiled bedding pack be removed and replaced with clean shavings.

SHOWMANSHIP:

Sheep shown in Showmanship classes do NOT have to be owned by the exhibitor. Appropriate class is determined by exhibitor age at show time.

- 01. **SHOWMANSHIP:** Junior 9 years & under
- 02. **SHOWMANSHIP:** Intermediate 10 to 18 years
- 03. **SHOWMANSHIP:** Senior: over 18 YEARS

- 04. **Pen of 2 Market lambs**
- 05. **Market Lamb (Ewe or Wether)**
- 06. **Champion Market Lamb. Rosettes only**

- 09 19 29 39 **EWE YEARLING:** third pair of temporary incisors must be in place.
- 10 20 30 40 **EWE LAMB:** first pair of temporary incisors must be in place. Born the property of the exhibitor.
- 11 21 31 41 **EWE:** Champion & Reserve from previous class to determine overall Champion & Reserve. Rosettes courtesy of IPE.
- 12 22 32 42 **RAM MATURE:** 2 yrs and older
- 13 23 33 43 **RAM YEARLING:** third pair of temporary incisors must be in place.
- 14 24 34 44 **RAM LAMB:** First pair of temporary incisors must be in place. Born the property of the Exhibitor.
- 15 25 35 45 **RAM:** Champion & Reserve from previous classes to determine overall Champion & Reserve. Rosettes courtesy of the IPE.
- 16 26 36 46 **GET OF SIRE:** Born the property of the exhibitor. A group of 3 animals. by the same sire. Both sexes may be represented. Animals may or may not have been shown in preceding classes
- 17 27 37 47 **BREEDERS FLOCK:** Bred and owned by the exhibitor. A group of 4 animals both sexes to be represented. Each animal in the group must have been exhibited in one of the preceding classes.

All Supreme Champion Classes will run at the end of the regular classes. Registered & Commercial sheep will be included in the Supremes classes. **Rosettes only** courtesy of IPE.

FLEECE COMPETITION:

Thursday August 30. Livestock Barn Show Ring

Fleece to be on grounds ready to set up by 9:30 am

Limited to 2 entries per exhibitor.

Exhibitors to indicate the breed/cross of the sheep from which the fleece was shorn.

Fleece must be from sheep owned by the exhibitor during the current year.

Fleece length to be a minimum of 2" presented in a clear plastic bag.

All fleece will be classified into their proper classes before judging.

Fleece may be opened at time of judging at the judges discretion.

All fleece not picked up by exhibitors after the fair will become the property of the IPE.

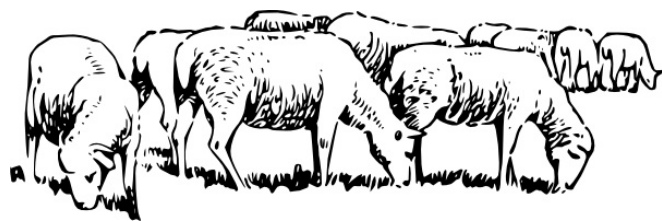
