*Queen, Drones, Workers. Fair time is usually late for drones. This requires close timing between preparation and judging time.

SIZE: Containers to be 1 lb jars or kg equivalent, net weight unless stated otherwise.

FRAMES: to be enclosed in glass or firm plastic.

- 05. Novice Class, liquid honey (6). (Open only to first time exhibitors)
- 06. Beeswax, not less than 2 lbs
- 07. Novice class in wax 1 lb
- 08. Deep Frame
- 09. Shallow Frame
- 10. Honey Comb, 6 sections
- 11. Six cut comb in covered containers
- 12. Educational and attractive display of 30 lbs or 14 kg of honey and wax 4'x4' space. Score of this class
 - Educational Features 40 points
 - Attractiveness 30 points
 - Quality 30 points

Educational Features include showing uses of honey in cooking, health products, etc. and/or honey varieties and hive products. Include relevant information.
