SPECIAL ATTENTION is called to the **Commitment to Animal Care, General Rules & Regulations** printed at the beginning of the prize list. Failure to abide by IPE rules may result in disqualification, forfeiture of prize money & possible disbarment from the fair.

VETERINARY CHECKS All swine upon arrival to IPE grounds (Tues, Aug 30) will be subject to a mandatory vet check with owner of animal present.

ALL GOVERNMENT TAGS (pig trace) must be in place prior to IPE. As of May 1, 2019, the CFIA approved the use of ear tattoos on litters accompanying sow if moved for educational purposes such as the IPE. The ear tattoo number, made up of 5 alpha numeric characters is allocated by the Canadian Pork Council & refers to a group of swine that originate from the same farm. INSURANCE LIABILITY All animal owners must have liability insurance when competing with livestock at the IPE. Please add the IPE as an additional insurer on your liability insurance. Send copy to swine@armstrongipe.com prior to the IPE.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

1. All animals entering the barns should be properly vaccinated, dewormed, & deloused. Swine must be properly & completely castrated (unless still nursing)
2. All entries must be ear tagged and/or tattooed
3. All pens must be cleaned out by 8am each morning and manure placed outside no later than 9am
4. No exhibition/stall displays to be removed until 10:15pm Sept 4th or prize money will be forfeited
5. 4-H entries cannot be shown in open classes

MOVE IN DATE all day Tues, August 30th until 5pm

MOVE OUT DATE After 10:15pm Sun, Sept 4th. See rule #4

JUDGING Wed, August 31st - Open classes @ 8:30am / 4-H classes @ 9am
