SPECIAL ATTENTION is called to the Commitment to Animal Care and General Rules & Regulations printed at the beginning of the prize list. Failure to abide by IPE rules may result in disqualification, forfeiture of prize money, and possible disbarment from the Interior Provincial Exhibition.

<u>VETERINARY CHECKS</u> Swine will be subject to a veterinary check once on IPE premises. Thee will be an inspection Tuesday, August 27th 6pm and Wednesday, August 28th prior to showing.

NOTE: The IPE reserves the right to substitute a threeperson health check committee to observe and maintain the health of animals during the duration of the IPE.

LIVESTOCK INFORMATION

- 1. Pig trace must be in place prior to IPE. Send copy of your **Pig Trace Movement Report** to swine@armstrongipe.com
- 2. All entries must be ear tagged and/or tattooed. The CFIA approved the use of ear tattoos on litters accompanying sow if moved for educational purposes such as the IPE. The ear tattoo number, made up of 5 alpha numeric characters is allocated by the Canadian Pork Council & refers to a group of swine that originate from the same farm.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- 1. All animals entering the barns should be healthy with proper vaccinations plus dewormed & deloused. Swine must be properly & completely castrated (unless still nursing)
- 2. All pens must be cleaned by 8am each morning and manure placed outside no later than 9am
- 3. 4-H entries cannot be shown in open classes

MOVE OUT DATE No Swine or displays to be removed until Monday, September 2nd.
