SPECIAL ATTENTION is called to the **General Rules & Regulations** printed at the beginning of the prize list.

Failure to abide by IPE rules may result in disqualification, forfeiture of prize money and possible disbarment from the fair.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- 1. Exhibits to be grown in 2024 unless late harvested type crops.
- 2. Exhibits to be correctly labeled with name of variety. 10% of points will be deducted where correct variety name is not
- 3. Judging will be in accordance with rules in Circular #50C, available through Ministry of Agriculture. All seed inwritten on entry sheet of exhibitor.
- 4. Classes 1-14 inclusive must be grown by exhibitor and not previously shown at the IPE.
- 5. **Sheaf classes:** Must be tied in two places. First tie immediately below head and second tie proportionate to length of sheaf. The **diameter of the whole being 2½" (6 cm)** first tie. Conformity to this size taken into consideration by judge. Grain for making a sheaf does not need to be grown by exhibitor. **REMEMBER:** A well prepared exhibit of sheaves is a great asset to any show. See picture below.
- 6. **Sheaf building:** Great exhibit to set up. For convenience make a temporary mould. Line up the stem heads. discard the loose leaves as you go. Once the diameter is approx 3" tighten with a tie just below the head of the sheaf. Once the final lenght is decided you can add a second tie. Trim the stem so sheaf is even and can stand on table.
